Please label everything with your child's name:

1 lined steno pad (see example below)

1 (11x14) transparent string (or velcro) closure vinyl envelope (see example below)

1 pair of child-safe scissors

1 pack of construction paper

1 zipper pencil pouch (simple sturdy plastic or fabric) (see example below)

1 pair of plain slip-on slippers (free of jutting character heads) (see example below)

1 pack of diapers (for those not yet toilet-trained)

1 seasonal change of clothing sent in a sealable/ reusable plastic baggie

2 packs of baby wipes

1 (yoga) mat and sleeping bag or blanket for afternoon nap (for full day or extended session)

1 bin with a lid that will close and hold sleeping bag or blanket and yoga mat (for full day or extended session)

2 containers of Lysol/Clorox wipes

1 can of Lysol disinfectant spray

1 box of 250 count tissues

1 thermos with a cover and drinking spout (to use for drinking water during the day) (see example below)


1 rectangular lunch box with handle (no back pack straps)
